People Working Cooperatively Receives \$20,000 from UPS for Veterans Home Repairs *Grant will support Veterans*

CINCINNATI – People Working Cooperatively (PWC), a local nonprofit that provides critical home repair, weatherization, modification and maintenance services to help residents stay safely in their homes, announced today it has received \$20,000 from UPS to install a ramp a month in 2014 for our low-income clients who are veterans or the immediate family of a deceased veteran.

“We set out to change the lives of those veterans who needed our services,” said Jock Pitts, president of People Working Cooperatively. “I’m grateful to say that the generosity UPS has shown has given us the opportunity to change the lives of 12 more veterans and their families.”

UPS has a standing relationship with People Working Cooperatively and its’ work with veterans. Last fall, UPS partnered with PWC in the Ramp It Up For Veterans Campaign during which time, 60 veteran clients had home modifications completed, specifically ramps installed.
