Are you interested in helping elderly and disabled people in your community?

Join us for Prepare Affair Saturday, November 12, 2011 to rake leaves and clean gutters for elderly and disabled homeowners in your community. It's a great opportunity to help out and give back... and instantly make a positive, lasting impact on the lives of people who need your help.

• What happens during Prepare Affair?

Prepare Affair volunteers meet at homes all over southwestern Ohio, northern Kentucky, and southeastern Indiana on Nov. 12 (or another designated day for some groups if needed) to provide fall clean-up and winter preparation for low-income homeowners who are elderly or disabled. Your group will meet in the morning to gather information and supplies, then head to the first client's home.

• What will I do during Prepare Affair?

Work includes raking leaves, cleaning up yard debris, cleaning gutters, and other minor tasks. We especially need volunteers that can transport ladders and serve as gutter cleaners (training is available if needed).

• Are the homes I visit during Prepare Affair pre-qualified by PWC? Yes. All clients served fall within our income guidelines.

• May I bring my friends or children? Yes. Prepare Affair is more than a community event; it is a family event, so bring your kids along!

• Is Prepare Affair free? Yes, however we encourage donations to cover the cost of the T-shirts. Our suggestion is \$10 per person or \$20 per family, and this is optional. You can

• Is PWC solely a volunteer-operated program? No. PWC operates 365 days a year with professional staff providing critical home repairs, energy conservation and weatherization, mobility modifications, and maintenance services. Over 85% of our services are critical home repairs (heating, electrical, roofing, plumbing) and weatherization performed by licensed, trained professionals. One of many programs offered to our elderly and disabled homeowners is the Volunteer Involvement Program. Volunteers help year-round with the simple home maintenance that is often so difficult for that population.
