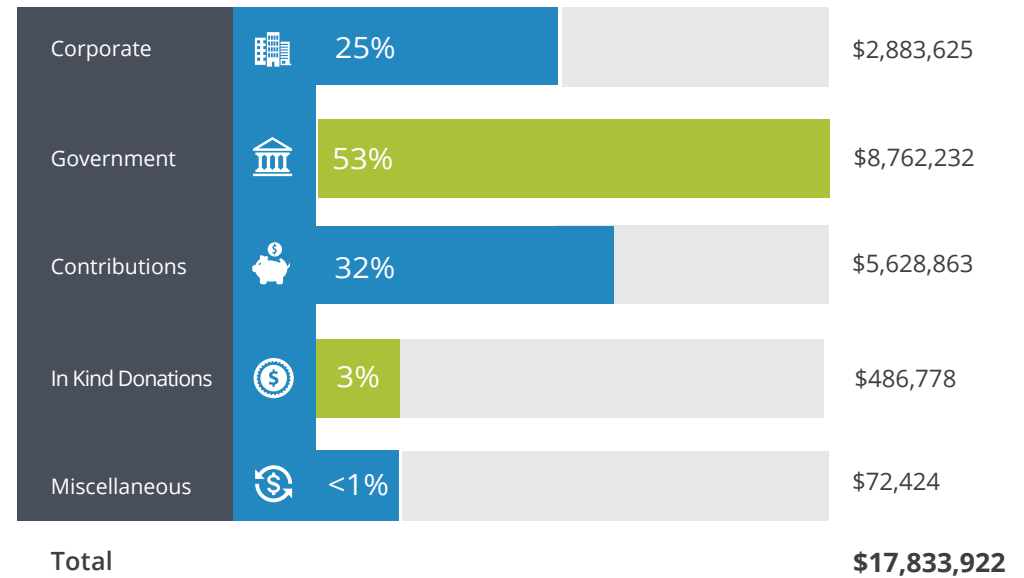

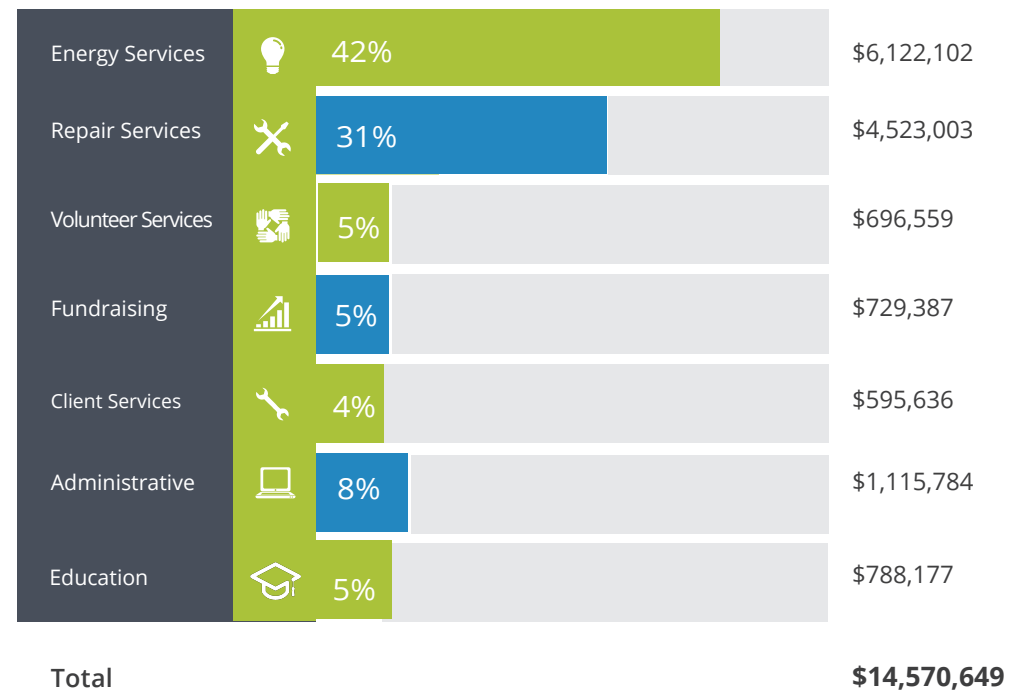

2022 Revenue



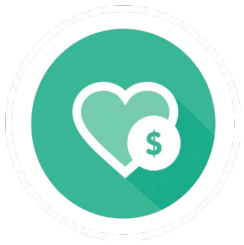

2022 Impact Highlights



Historical Year for Funding

2022 is the biggest funding year in PWC's 48 year history. Revenue in 2022 was up, totaling \$17.5M.



ToolBelt Ball Returns

ToolBelt Ball returns to an in-person event after a 2-year hiatus and nets more than \$238k, an event record.



PWC Workforce Development

In partnership with Allied Construction Industries, PWC launches a Workforce Development pilot for new and existing field staff.



Largest Private Donation

PWC received the single largest private donation in agency history of \$2.5M from the Farmer Family Foundation to reduce the waiting list in Hamilton, Butler, Warren and Clermont counties in Ohio.



Whole Home Innovation Center

From reducing lead poisoning and asthma triggers in children, to helping seniors age-in-place, PWC's Whole Home Innovation Center continues to focus on the home environment and improve lives. Over 688 services were provided reducing the strain on healthcare systems, nursing homes and social services.



Volunteer Impact

360 volunteers donated 1,400 hours of service to complete approximately 48 home repair projects for the 40th annual spring Repair Affair and 1,500 volunteers (100+ individual groups) donated approximately 3,500 hours of service to assist 560 homeowners for the 36th annual fall Prepare Affair event.



Emerging Leaders Host Boards & Brews

First annual signature event executed by PWC's Emerging Leaders Board is a success. Boards & Brews combines a homebrewing contest and cornhole tournament in conjunction with Sam Adams Cincinnati Taproom.
