JOB SUMMARY

Perform maintenance, repairs, and modifications of HVAC systems. Meet production goals in accordance with Weatherization Programs and all applicable manufacturer's specifications, federal, state, and local laws as well as PWC policies.

- Use all HVAC tools including: combustion analyzer, refrigeration gauges, recovery equipment, air meters, leak detectors, manometer, multi-meter, pressure differential equipment, and troubleshooting equipment.
- Maintain an inventory of assigned tools and equipment in good condition.
- Complete accurate and detailed paperwork.
- Load and unload trucks as required; maintaining truck stock to perform regular maintenance.
- Make necessary repairs to all types of heating and cooling equipment.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
